

X-Translate 3.1 Release Notes

1. Installing X-Tools

Important

Uninstall the previous version of X-Tools before installing a new version.
Close any open ACRA CONTROL tools before installing/uninstalling other ACRA CONTROL tools.

Note 1: X-Tools installation is not supported on the Windows 2000 operating system, as the installation includes .NET framework 4.0.

Note 2: The user should install and run X-Translate as an administrator on a Windows 7 operating system. This also applies to installation of Microsoft .NET Framework version 4.0.

3. Known issues in this release

| Issue # | Description |
|---------|--|
| XTL-9 | The message server window blocks X-Translate window |
| XTL-13 | X-Translate translates "DataLin.ProtocolProperties" into "Channel.Settings" but with "ProtocolPropeties.X" |
| XTL-20 | Opening a second instance of X-Translate will result in it crashing |
| XTL-22 | The 'Display Next Time' setting no longer appears on the GUI |
| XTL-44 | The X-Translate GUI partly obscures some buttons and text when using larger font sizes |
| XTL-51 | Parameter definitions containing FragmentMap elements not handled |
| XTL-56 | The 'Direction' attribute for a channel is not being set in the translation and this leads to validation errors in the translated XidML file |
| XTL-58 | X-Translate crashes when canceling the file browse wizard |
| XTL-60 | X-Translate failed to translate a master-slave task file due to "multiple inter-connects with same vendor name" error. |
